This Sunday's worship is in the Cathedral!

We are now live streaming our 10:30 am service on Facebook and YouTube. We are working to also be able to broadcast that service on our website.

We will have an 8:00 am Eucharist - Rite I in the Garden Room, a 10:30 am worship in the Cathedral; and, during Lent, we have a 7:00 am Rite I Holy Eucharist on Monday and Friday in the Chapel and Wednesday in the Garden Room.

COMMUNION WILL BE GIVEN TO ONE PERSON AT A TIME – WHILE THE REST OF THE CONGREGATION REMAINS SEATED. Only the Bread of the consecration will be shared with the congregation.

On Sunday evenings, Dean Alston Johnson is leading a new Inquirers/Confirmation class. This class is for anyone wanting to be confirmed by the Bishop in May or anyone just wanting to learn more about the Episcopal Church.

Class will be held in the Parish Hall at 6:00 pm. All COVID-19 protocols will be followed.
