One of our oldest St. Mark's Lenten traditions is the Fasting Fund. Baskets are placed out for the 7:00 a.m. Eucharist services and the base of the steps to the chancel for Sunday services to collect these offerings. This year the fund will be dedicated to the Caddo Council on Aging Meals on Wheels program. Please consider making the Fasting Fund a part of your Lenten observance.

Communion Celebration Weekend is the weekend of April 17 and 18. This is a special weekend where children gather to learn why we take Holy Communion.
