One of St. Mark's Lenten traditions is the Fasting

Fund. The purpose is simple: We ask that you forgo one meal a week, and contribute a few dollars - what you would have spent on that meal to the fasting fund. This year's offering will go to The Bridge Alzheimer's & Dementia Resource Center
