Ash Wednesday is February 22. Services of Holy Eucharist and Imposition of Ashes will be held at 7:00 am in the Chapel, and at 8:00 am (School service) noon and 5:30 pm in the Cathedral.

Jewell House was the first shelter in north Louisiana designed specifically to serve homeless girls and remains the only one to provide shelter beyond 21 days. From its inception, Youth Outreach Services has had a consistent record of success.
