It's a well-known tradition for Christians to give up something as part of a Lenten discipline. At St. Mark's, a Lenten tradition for almost 20 years has been The Fasting Fund. As part of our Lenten observance, parishioners are asked to forego one or two meals a week and put the average cost of the missed meals in one of the wicker baskets placed beside the steps leading to the Chancel and altar rail or on the small table in the back of the chapel. This year, the Fasting Fund will go to Jewell House, a transitional living facility for homeless girls ages 13 - 21. Jewell House was the first shelter in north Louisiana designed specifically to serve homeless girls and remains the only one to provide shelter beyond 21 days. From its inception, Youth Outreach Services has had a consistent record of success.

#### We are proud to introduce 5 Loaves and 2 Fish!

They serve Shreveport with multiple ministries: food bank, diaper bank, bible studies, life learning classes, weekend conferences, and summer camps. ALL events and ministries are based and centered around Christian teachings and values.

St. Mark's will be helping with a diaper drive for the month of MARCH. Please bring any size/quantity diapers to the church office.
