Opportunities to work with our youth take many forms. Maybe you could provide snacks for an activity. Maybe you could teach a Sunday school class for just 6 weeks. Maybe you could be a mentor to a youth that is growing in their faith. Maybe you could host the youth for an event that is off the church campus. Maybe you could lead a small group for 20 minutes

at Sunday night EYC. Maybe you feel called to lead a bible study for high schoolers. Maybe you are crafty and can help make decorations for special events. Maybe you could be a chaperone on a mission trip or some other adventure. The list of possibilities is endless.

When I was in elementary, middle and high school I was very involved in activities at my church. The adults that stand out in my memory as having the most impact on me were not the parents of other youth. Some of them had children that were already grown. Some of them had children that were too young for youth. Some of them didn't have children at all. Some were Sunday school teachers. Some went with us on trips. Some were just in the building when we had regular events. What stands out to me most looking back is that they were not there because they were parents and they had to be there. They were there because they wanted to be there. There is room for all types of gifts and all levels of commitment.
