Our Daily Lenten Eucharists are back. We meet each Monday – Friday morning at 7:00 am in the Chapel.

The Cross of Nails community will have a training on Wednesday, March 6, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm in the Garden Room. All interested are welcome to attend. Purchased, not for Sale will be leading this training. This is the first of the ministries we will be involved in. Many of the ministries we already have ongoing fit nicely into the goals of the Community of the Cross of Nails. (Don't forget, we will be receiving our Cross on March 10.)

There will be a retirement dinner for the Rev. Rowena White on Thursday, March 7 at 6:00 pm in the Parish Hall. We are collecting a purse and cards to celebrate Rowena's ministry with us. You can mail checks and cards or drop them by the church.

Columbarium renderings are available for viewing in the Narthex of the Cathedral. This project is underway and includes 384 additional columbarium niches beautifully nestled in our courtyard behind the flagpoles. One of St. Mark's Lenten traditions is the Fasting Fund. The purpose is simple: We ask that you forgo one meal a week, and contribute a few dollars - what you would have spent on that meal - to the fasting fund. Baskets are placed at the back of the chapel for the 7:00 a.m. Eucharist services and the base of the steps to the chancel for Sunday services to collect these offerings. The recipient of this year's Lenten Fasting Fund is The Gingerbread House Children's Advocacy Center. Serving on average 76 new child abuse victims every month, children as young as 2 years old and as old as 17 receive private forensic interviews to disclose the details of their abuse in a professional, child-friendly atmosphere to help reduce trauma to the child and family. The Gingerbread House also provides a vast array of services including counseling, advocacy, and prevention education. All services are provided free of charge so that no child is ever turned away due to a family's inability to pay.

Come sing with us! The St. Mark's Cathedral Choirs rehearse on Wednesdays (Boys and Girls Choir at 4:15 pm and the Cathedral Choir at 6:15 pm) and all are invited to the family dinner at 5:30 pm.
